Does your organisation have an Access and Inclusion Plan?

All significant change needs a plan to succeed and becoming an accessible workplace is no exception. A plan will help guide your organisation and improve decision-making.

Perhaps you need support to scope, consult, develop and launch your Access and Inclusion Plan (also known as Disability Action Plan)? Whether you have not yet started, or you are unsure of your next steps, we can help.

Be guided through informative workshops, hear from guest speakers sharing top tips and learn from other organisations on the journey. Including debriefing workshops where you work on the development of your plan.

At the end of the AIP Master Class, you will have all the resources, knowledge and understanding you need to create an Access and Inclusion Plan.



Masterclass details

This 3 month course comprises of 8 sessions ranging from 45 to 90 minutes, all held online. The course is split between workshops and collaboration sessions. The Workshops are broken into three clear milestones of project delivery: Engage, Consult and Deliver.

There will be time between workshops to put learnings into practice and progress your plan through your organisation.

Additionally, we will provide resources and templates to help the process including project plans, Access and Inclusion Plans, questionnaires, communications etc.

Cost

The structure of the program is based on organisations enrolment (rather than individuals). Up to three participants from an organisation can attend.

We recommend Diversity and Inclusion Practitioners and Disability Employee Network members (if established).

Member—\$7,000 + GST or 28 member hours (per organisation)

Non-members—\$9,000 + GST (per organisation)
